## Respect for Differences

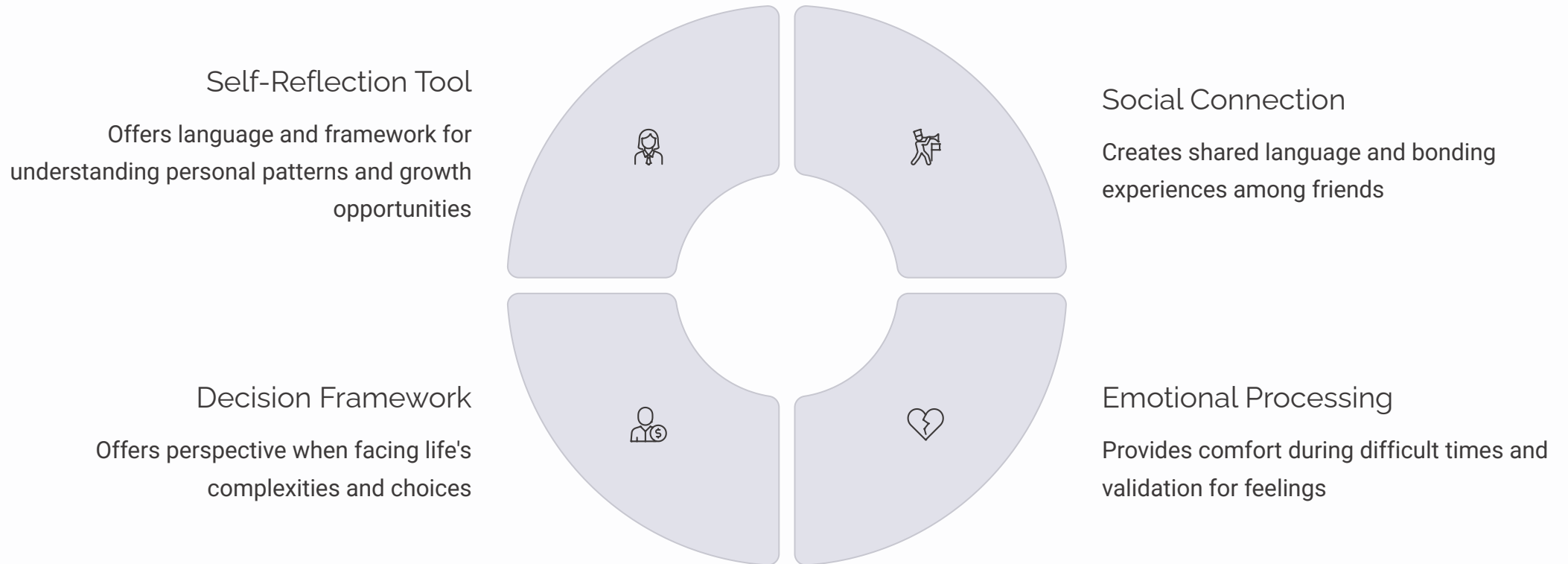
Your handling of her interest in birth charts previews how you'll respond to differences in other areas: career choices, family dynamics, and personal growth paths.

**Why it fails:** Prioritizes being "right" over connecting with her emotional experience

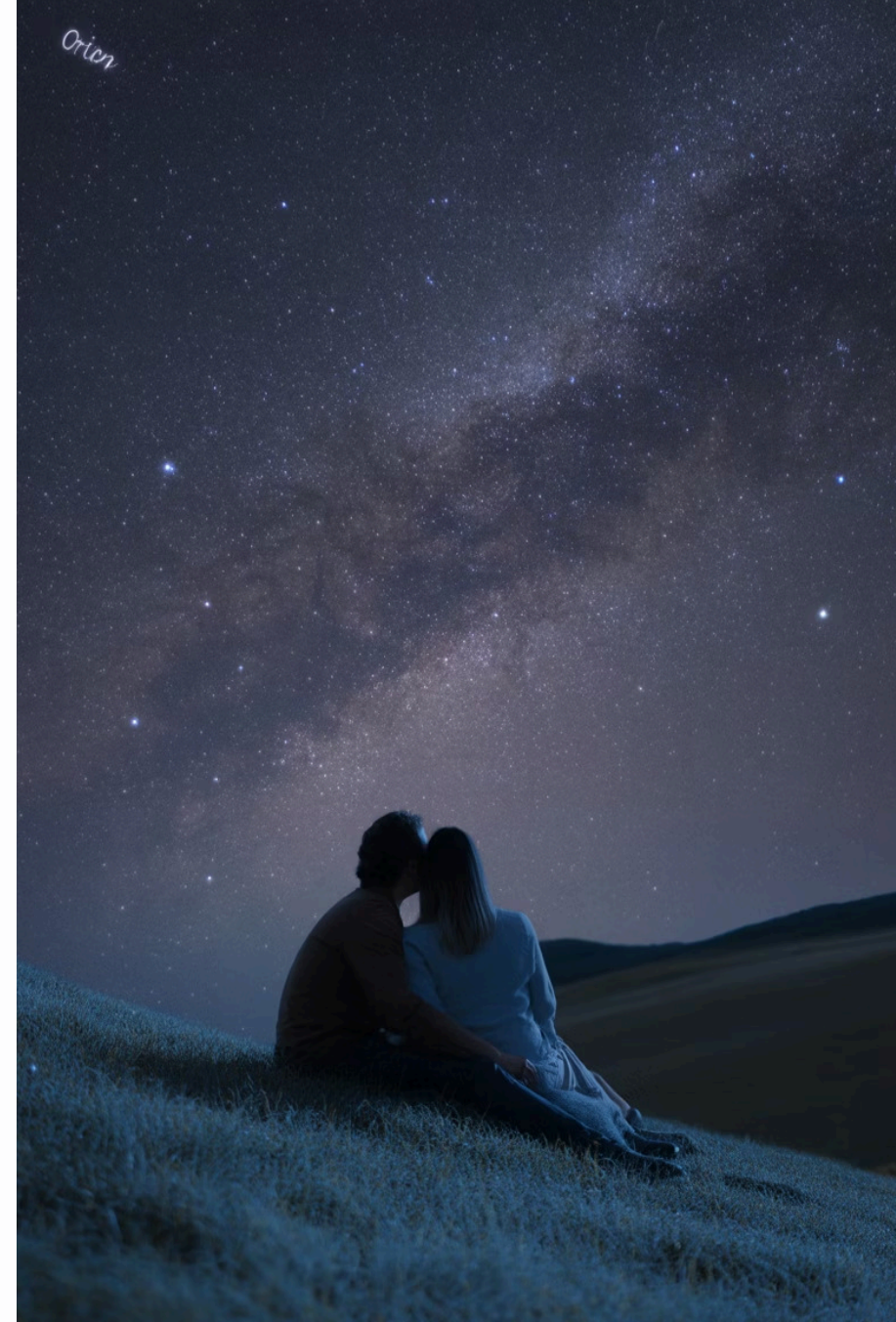
The first response opens a door to understanding her inner world, while the second closes it firmly—potentially setting a pattern for how emotional sharing will be received throughout the relationship.
